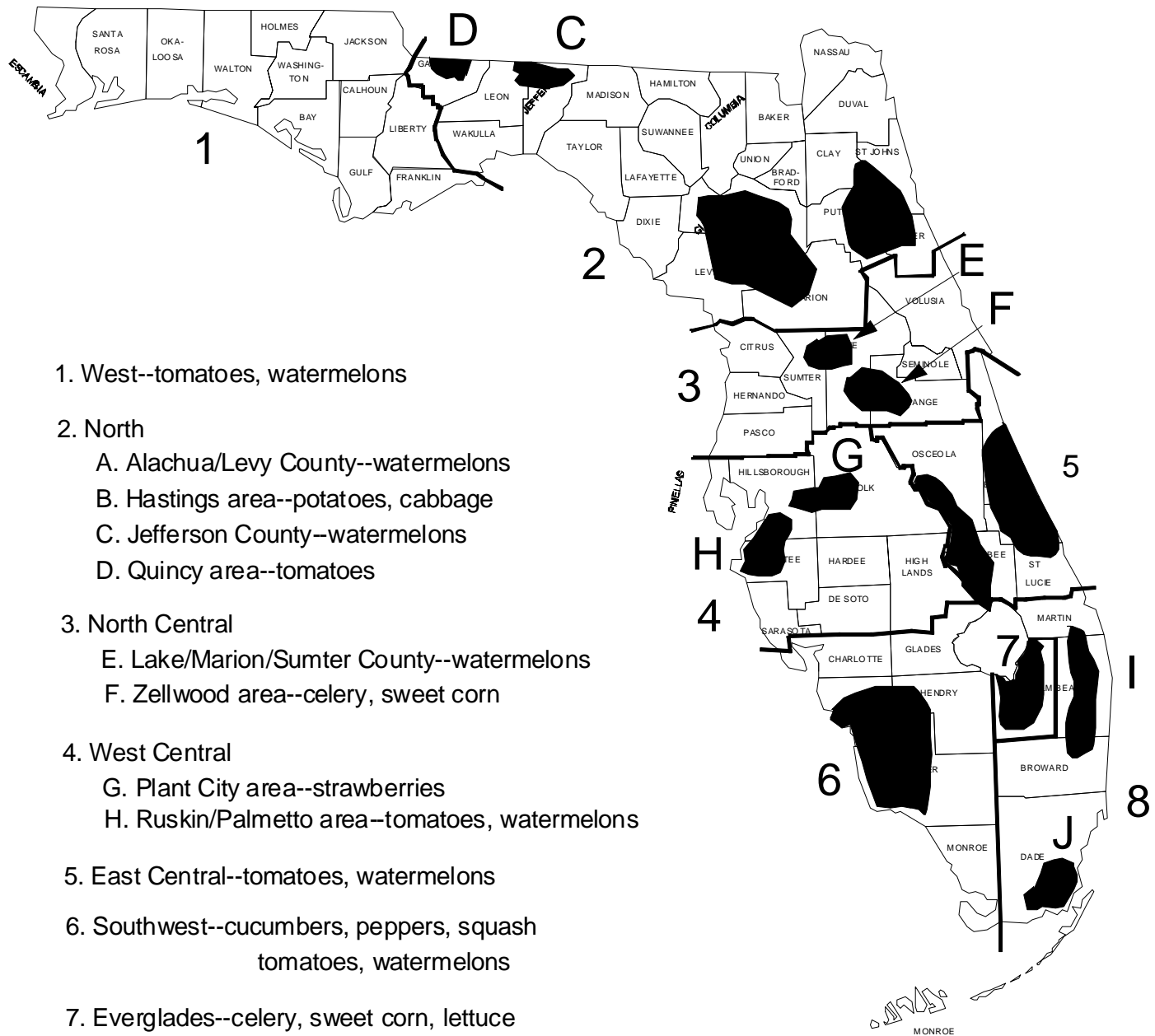


# PRINCIPAL VEGETABLE PRODUCING AREAS IN FLORIDA AND MAJOR VEGETABLES PRODUCED
