## Criteria for Selection:

**Selection of the scholars will be based on the following criteria, to be determined:**

- **Interest of the applicant in pursuing a career in agricultural marketing and management or international food and resource economics**
- **Grade Point Average/Undergraduate coursework and college entrance test scores (minimum 3.0 GPA)**
- **Letters of recommendation (required to submit two letters)**
- **Characteristics which foster diversity including experiences, socioeconomic background, talents, race, gender and similar attributes**

**Students of all races and ethnicities are encouraged to apply.**

**Additionally, students must be citizens or nationals of the United States, newly enrolled in FRE and be full-time students.**

**Interested students must apply to the University of Florida prior to the June 1 deadline for Fall 2008 admission.**
